Going from producing relish in her kitchen for local shops and restaurants, to moving into purposely built kitchens in Little Island.



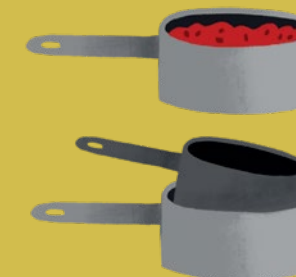
2019
